

**Please note the following correction to the Gospel of John, Lesson 6:**

- Questions for Reflection, page 68, asks, “Do you feel ever feel stuck in your sinful ways and the fear of making changes in your lifestyle paralyzes you from making the right choice? (Change to: “Do you ever feel stuck in your sinful ways? Does the fear of making changes in your lifestyle paralyze you from making the right choice?)
- Points to Ponder, page 69, fourth paragraph, the first sentence begins, “Oddly and amazingly, because...” (Cross out the word “because” in the sentence.)
- Points to Ponder, page 69, fourth paragraph, the third sentence states, “It is possible to become attached to our suffering, to cling to it for our identity, to savor the pity it evokes and be glad of the labor it excuses us from.” (Change this sentence to: It is possible to become attached to our suffering, to cling to it for our identity, to savor the pity it evokes and be glad of the way it excuses us from having to do labor.”
- Points to Ponder, page 71, the first partial paragraph states, “But Jesus is doing more than claiming to be (the) Messianic Son of David and therefore a “priest according to Melchizekek.” (cf. Psalm 110:4; Hebrews 7:20).” (Insert “the” as indicated and change the Hebrews verse to Hebrews 7:17.)
- Summary, page 73, point # 1, begins, “John records the story of the man at the pool, now only to describe...” (Change the word “now” to “not” in the sentence.)
