

**Please note the following corrections to the Gospel of John, Lesson 10:**

- Replace “Exodus 8:15” with “Exodus 8:19” in both study question # 5 (page 104) and in the Responses to the Questions, # 5 (page 24).
- Study Question #8, page 105, “...What do these verses of the *CCC* have to do with Jesus’ telling the woman caught in adultery to “go, and do not sin again” after he telling her she is forgiven? (Change “telling” to “tells” in the question.)
- Question 9, page 105, “...How many kinds of contrition are there? What are they? What is the difference between the two? (substitute “them” for “the two” at the end of the sentence.)
- Points to Ponder, page 107, first paragraph, the last sentence ends with “...immoral since Jesus supposed “forbade” it.” (Change “supposed” to “supposedly” in the sentence.)
- Points to Ponder, page 107, second paragraph, the second sentence begins, “Jesus, for instance, cites (the) Torah with approval...” (Add “the” before “Torah” in the sentence.)
- Rome to Home, (Papal Quote), page 110, the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> paragraphs begin with “It is not...” (Change to “Is it not...”)
