

Please note the following corrections to the Gospel of John, Lesson 11:

- Study Question #1, page 114, (See Psalm 27:1 & 36:10; Ephesians 5, Acts 9:3 & 1 John 1:5)

Change to: (See Psalm 27:1 & 36:9; Ephesians 5:8-14, Acts 9:3 & 1 John 1:5)

- Study Question #6, page 115, begins, “In verse 31 Jesus says, “the truth will make you free.” (Change to verse 32.)

- “From Rome to Home”, the Papal Quote on page 120, the second paragraph:

2. The salvific liberation effected by Christ in regard to man contains in itself, in a certain sense, two dimensions: liberation ‘from’ (evil) and liberation ‘for the’ (good), which are intimately united, and mutually condition and complete each other” (Pope John Paul II, General Audience, August 3, 1988).

Changes are needed at the beginning and at the end of this paragraph. Change “2. The salvific liberation...” to “The salvific liberation...” and move the period to the end of the sentence (...and complete each other.”)
