

**Please note the following corrections to the Gospel of John, Lesson 21:**

- Questions for Reflection #1, page 216, change the sentence that states, “But God tells us to “never cease praying” (Luke 18:1) to: “But Jesus tells us “always to pray and not lose heart” (Luke 18:1).
- Questions for Reflection #2, page 217, begins, “Jesus said that he was glorified in his apostles (verse 11).” Change verse 11 to verse 10.
- Responses to the Questions #3, page 47, the second to the last sentence includes, “...Moses blessed the twelve tribes of Israel (Deut. 33:15)...” (Change to Deut. 33:1-29.)
- Responses to the Questions #4, page 47, the last sentence states “...they not only were to glorify Christ in their actions but the were his representatives on earth,..” (Change “the” to “they” in the sentence.)
- Responses to the Questions #7, page 47, the last sentence states, “That Jesus has to ask his Father to guard and protect his friends from the evil one shows us that Satan is indeed ‘prowling the world seeking souls to devour’ (1 Peter 5:8).”

Change to: That Jesus has to ask his Father to guard and protect his friends from the evil one shows us that Satan “prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour” (1 Peter 5:8).
